2	Volume I Section 18.1 Sr. No. 5 Page No. 108 Roles and Responsibilities of System Integrator (SI)	It should be read as: Insurance after the Hardware has been supplied and Commissioned at the DC and DRC will be the responsibility of MMTC. Until then the Insurance of all hardware items for the DC & DRC will be SI’s responsibility. Insurance policy should be standard EEI and F&B policy.
3	Volume I Annexure IV IT infrastructure specifications, Page No. 127-128 Storage and Backup Solutions, point (d)	It is clarified : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The RPO is also 4 hours.</li> <li>• The time taken for restoration of the system is addressed in the SLA.</li> <li>• The recommended duration for the back-up of the data at the passive site (DR site) is 20 minutes. However, the bidder shall make all arrangements to implement a solution at DR site that ensure that there will be Zero Data loss through appropriate backup plan.</li> </ul>
