Following Clauses are amended and to be read as under:

Clause 2: Items, Quantity and Shipment Period

^{*} Quantity can be increased or decreased at the sole discretion of MMTC depending on the prices received in the tender. Preference would be given to early shipment. Early delivery schedule and competitive prices are essence of this tender.

Suppliers may submit their offer separately for containerized cargo and break bulk vessel in the price bid.

Total quantity of a bidder for all the shipment schedules should not be less than 1000 MT. Shipment in more than one lot is allowed.

In case seller ships more than 90% of material within weekly shipment schedule Liquidated Clause would not be applied and balance will automatically add to next shipment schedule.

In case of containerized cargo, Bidders shall agree to move the cargo to a destination other than the one offered by them in case so required by MMTC. Suppliers to specify number of containers they can offer for such movement (min 14 containers). Sellers will obtain necessary permission from Shipping Lines to allow such movement to CFS/ICDs at Hyderabad/Tughlaqabad. In such cases, the movement arrangements and additional cost of movement of the containers

from Port to the ultimate CFS/ICDs shall be arranged and borne by MMTC. However, in such cases of movement of sealed containers from Nhava Sheva to the newly declared CFS/ICD destination, suppliers shall agree for inspection at the final destination wherein quality and quantity shall be final and binding on both the supplier and the buyer.

3. Specifications General:-

- (i) Colour and shape: The onion bulb should be whitish colour with globular round in shape. The onion bulb should be well dried (cured), thin neck along with 2-3 dried skin.
- (ii) The Onion bulb size should be in between 40 mm to 80 mm (Bulb size below 40 mm or above 80 mm should not exceed 5% of total quantity supplied in the lot)
- (iii) Onion should be fresh and of good quality. They shall be characteristics of the variety and/or commercial type. The bulb shall be :- firm and compact; unsprouted (free from externally visible shoots);- properly cured and cleaned; free from swelling caused by abnormal development; free of root tufts.

- (iv) The bulb should be free from mechanical damage/injury, doubles/splitting, sprouting/bolting, soft/mushy.
- (v) The bulb should not be wet. It should be free from fungal/bacterial/insect infestation and also free from mould infestation.
- (vi)The bulb should moderately pungent.
- (vii) Cargo should be free from Carbon damage, root, Mechanical Damage, Soft & Mushy, fungus infestation.
- viii) Any deviation from above quality parameters may attract penalty /rejection of cargo at the sole discretion of MMTC/its buyers. Also please see SI.No.9 of Annexure VI. All requirements of plant quarantine (regulation of import into India) Order 2003 and FSSAI or any amendments thereof to be strictly adhered to failing which the consignment will stand rejected. Also please see SI.No.9 of Annexure VI. ix) Radioactive contamination, if any, within permissible international limits. x) The cargo has to be shipped in Containers suitable for shipment of Onions with humidity control so as to retain the quality of the shipped onions in transit.
